GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION PAPERS

The abstracts must be submitted in electronic format by e-mail and with a maximum of 250 words.

HEADLINES

Title /Name of the authors / Organization / Country / Address, Phone, Fax and e-mail address

Language: English

Preferably: International System

Alternative: Metric System

The papers should be submitted:

- With a maximum of 20 pages, including, front page, picture, graphics, diagrams, tables, bibliographic references, etc. for an oral presentation with 15 minutes.
- Page numbers should be inserted in the centre bottom of each page.
- All the papers should be submitted in the official language of the Congress, in English and in any case in Spanish.
- Electronically by direct e-mail
- Word format with font Arial 12 printed in black.
- Graphics and pictures should be included in the Word document.
- The front page should only include the title of the conference and the name of the authors, and the last one, the bibliography, with the title, author's name and the year of publication.
